For the fortieth edition of Art Brussels, Galerie Claire Gastaud brings together recent paintings by Milène Sanchez and ceramic sculptures by Victor Levai.

Like a sudden apparition, in a theatrical setting, the viewer is invited to enjoy an immersive, sensory experience in which the sparkle of Milène Sanchez's paintings and the deformation and brilliance of Victor Levai's ceramics intertwine in a fascinating dialogue between form and color, matter and movement. Both explore themes of transformation, fragility and resilience, inviting the viewer to contemplate the ephemeral beauty of life.

Although their mediums and approaches differ, both artists explore the visible and the invisible. Their creations invite us to plunge into an introspective journey, where the proposed experience transcends the boundaries of the tangible and reveals a spellbinding dance between the alliance of form and color.

Milène Sanchez

Milène Sanchez's paintings and waxes play with blur and sharpness, opacity and transparency. Flowers disappear, reappear, sprout from their own seeds, moving towards the light like paint. Milène Sanchez captures their movements to keep them alive. These are paintings built around the gesture of staring at a subject, moving towards it, away from it, sweeping it with her gaze. His research into color, light and the ephemeral gives rise to captured images and spontaneous impulses. It's not a question of embodying reality, nor of moving away from it, but of oscillating between the two. It's about finding a balance between flying and working zones, between running and drying.

Milène Sanchez's technique is characterized by the use of pigments that she prepares herself to achieve new hues, between natural and artificial tones. She works with oil paint and turpentine, and uses the glazing technique, superimposing successive thin layers to create a unique atmosphere in each of her canvases.

Victor Levai

Victor Levai's work is based on personal reflection and meticulous observation of the plant world; these two sources of inspiration are the essential elements that structure a sculptural, sensitive and dreamlike universe.

Her work stems from the observation of plants, whether studied in nature or discovered in botanical books. These are plants whose rhythm or astonishing structure have attracted the artist's attention. Victor Levai wishes to apprehend a form through studio work, in order to understand and fix it. Producing each leaf by hand, forging the curvature of a stem or branch, ultimately enables the artist to understand the mechanism of forms and to appropriate it to propose a reinterpretation.

" Victor Levai is a herbalist. His production is thus an exponential collection, as much a matter of nomenclature as of grimoire. Neither science nor magic predominates in this empirical approach to living things. Reasoned gathering is just as important as mystical wandering. This is how he goes about experimenting with renderings, petrifying the organic with his ceramic powers." Joël Riff
